Session Meeting Minutes:

The Session of the Family of Faith Church of Nevada, Iowa, met on Wednesday, June 13, 2012, at 6:10 PM at the home of Ron and Louise Meals. Those present were Elders Jim Axline, Jason Boyd, Karen Chance, Stacy Dobernecker, Ron Meals, Lori Mensing, and Moderator Pastor Scott Milsom.

Pastor Milsom called the meeting to order and opened the meeting with prayer. The study and discussion of leadership materials from the Evangelical Presbyterian Church was continued, led by Pastor Scott. Following this training session, a regular session meeting was held.

Clerk of Session Report: Elder Ron Meals presented the minutes from session's May 30 meeting. These minutes were accepted and approved. There was no correspondence to present at this time.

Worship Ministry Team Report: Elder Jason Boyd discussed and shared arrangements for handling audiovisual and media aspects of worship when various members of the worship ministry team are absent for summer vacation during the weeks and months ahead. Also discussed was the need to develop a better plan for arrangements to set up for worship each Sunday morning making use of worship ministry team members and others on a scheduled basis. Elder Jason discussed the need for the church to provide its own laptop computer to plan and display information for worship. There is also a need to provide a printer for this same purpose. A motion was made, seconded, and approved to use \$1000 of church funds for the purchase of a laptop computer and printer. Jason will make arrangements to get this accomplished. The Worship Ministry Team Report was accepted and approved.

Evangelism, Mission, and Outreach Ministry Team Report: Elder Lori Mensing reported that the adopt-a-road project is being put on hold because of the need to implement better safety measures and procedures. This project will be implemented in the fall. Lori also informed the session that progress is being made for arrangements of the printing of the emergency booklets that will be provided for church family members. She also reported meeting with the Lincoln Highway Day's committee and will keep the session updated as to how our church family could be involved with this event. The report from the Evangelism, Mission, and Outreach Ministry Team was accepted and approved.

Members Care Ministry Team: Elder Karen Chance reported the Members Care Ministry Team will be meeting next week. She will be discussing arrangements for a church picnic event that will take place this summer. Also an update was provided regarding the special needs of some family church members. The Members Care Ministry Team report was accepted and approved.

Board of Trustees Report: Elder Jim Axline provided a report on church expenses so far this month. He indicated that he is working on a report similar to what other elders have been giving regarding his responsibilities as moderator of the Board of Trustees, and will be doing this during one of the upcoming Sundays. The Board of Trustees report was accepted and approved.

Christian Education Ministry Report: Elder Stacy Dobernecker provided a reminder that Sunday School activities will be completed at the end of this month. The theme during the final weeks of Sunday School for children and youth has been a focus on the sovereignty of God and the presentation of the Gospel. The Christian Education Team report was accepted and approved.

Being there was no other business before the Session, the meeting was adjourned and closed with prayer.
